### Did you know Oak Park has a Library?

Perhaps you did know but have never used it. It is an untapped resource waiting for discovery. You have access to resources in the library for a variety of purposes. For those who love reading for entertainment, you can enjoy books from the fiction section. Books in this section provide a number of choices in various genres written from a Christian worldview and/or theme. For people who host small groups or Bible studies, there are devotionals and study materials--some with leader guides and multiple copies. The apologetics section provides resources helpful when looking for a defence of our faith. Explore Christian thinking through books written by renowned Christian preachers and theologians, as well as biographies and autobiographies of people of faith. There is a section with Bible Aids which can assist readers in gaining a greater understanding of the Bible. You can also find books that provide helpful insights on topics related to men or women, Christian living, and parenting. The kids video section is well-used and there are fiction books for children and teens.

At a time where Christian book stores are almost non-existent, the library might just have what you are looking for in terms of reading material and resources to support a deeper understanding of the Bible and a Christian worldview and perspective. We are currently exploring ways to overhaul and update the library. Watch for an upcoming survey in which you can provide input that will help us better understand how the library can best serve you and meet the needs of the congregation.
